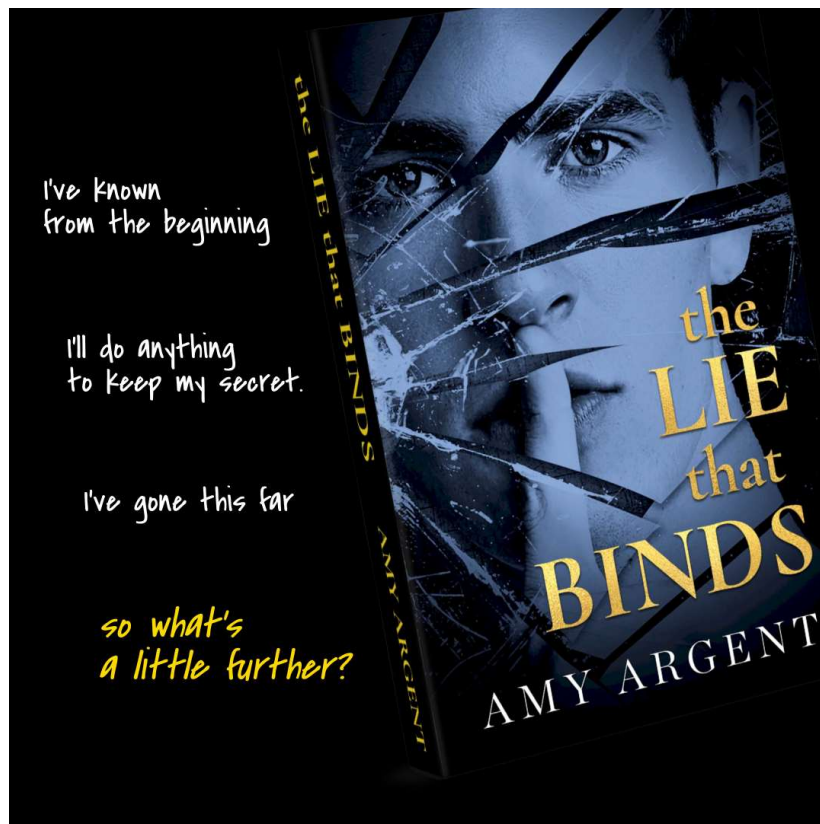




Hi Everyone! Summer is just around the corner--are you ready?

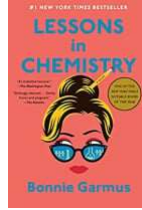

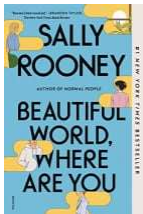

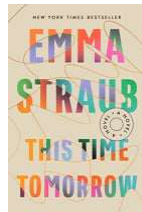
